

THIS IS WHAT WE'RE WORKING ON IN FAITH FORMATION CLASS:

Grade 1 – We are discussing Lent and keeping our Lenten calendar. We are also exploring the miracles of Jesus.

Grade 2 – We continue to rehearse for First Eucharist. We also are coloring the stations of the cross for our shadow boxes.

Grade 3 – We are focusing on the lives of the 12 Apostles and discussing the Last Supper.

Grade 4 – We continue to look deeper into the season of Lent. Our prayer chain continues to grow.

Grade 5 – We are discussing Lent and how to prepare ourselves for Holy Week and Easter. We are exploring the meaning of "True God and true man" via the comparison of "elites" to the common man and Jesus' rejection by the proud.

Grade 6 &7 – Assembled rice bowls to be given to students in Faith Formation. We are walking with Jesus by following the map of the Holy Land.

Grade 8, 9 & 10 - We gathered as a group to perform community service by assembling and packing "Prayer Packages " for college students in our Parish. We also discussed the Lenten season and how to live it out more fully.
