REGISTRATION

Registration for the Faith Formation year 2018 – 2019 is now open.

New Student registration is now being accepted for children who will be in grades 1 -10 in the Fall. Please remember that a child must attend two years of Faith Formation in order to make First Communion, usually beginning in first grade. A child must attend three years of Faith Formation in order to make Confirmation, usually beginning in eighth grade. First Communion candidates must be Baptized and at least 7 years old. Baptism can be arranged if necessary. Confirmation candidates must be at least 15 years old and have received Baptism and First Communion. Special circumstances are always taken into consideration. We have programs in place that can help a child accomplish the Sacraments of Baptism, First Communion and Confirmation.

Adult programs for the Sacraments are also available.

No one will ever be turned away.

Parents are encouraged to assist your child in their faith journey by continuing their Religious education in grades 3 and above.
