FOR REFLECTION

con·sub·stan·tial; of the same substance or essence (used especially of the three persons of the Trinity)

"Christ is consubstantial with the Father"

We pray the Creed every Sunday, but what does this word *CONSUBSTANTIAL* really mean. Do we understand its meaning or just mumble across the word and ask ourselves, Now, what does THAT mean? The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops website explains the word to mean: of the same substance or essence. In this case we profess Jesus Christ to be of the same substance (consubstantial) with God the Father.

But Why was it changed? The new translation is more in keeping with the ancient Latin text of the Creed and a more accurate translation in order to ensure that Jesus was professed as the eternal Son of God, equal to the Father, similarly stated: "We believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, of the same substance with the Father."
