



If you or a family member is hospitalized, please notify us.

LENT: Wednesday, February 22nd - Thursday, April 6th. Lent is a 40 day season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving that begins on Ash Wednesday and ends at sundown on Holy Thursday. Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. This is a period of preparation to celebrate the Lord's Resurrection at Easter. Easter Sunday is April 9th. 
