

PERSONAL CARE NECESSITIES DRIVE: Personal care and hygiene products are necessities, we all need them for our day-to-day comfort and health. But they are out of reach for too many people. More than 350,000 people in northeastern New York are often forced to make the choice between paying for housing and utilities or purchasing basic items like feminine hygiene products, diapers, toiletries, and other items not supported by SNAP (food stamps) benefits. In a Feeding America study of 350 food insecure households, families utilized coping strategies to deal with a lack of personal care or hygiene items:

- 88% extended product use by using less
- 69% skipped washing dishes or doing laundry
- 48% delayed changing a diaper
- 37% brushed teeth without toothpaste
- 33% bathed without soap

To fill this need, St. Michael's Evangelization Team will be holding a personal care necessi-



ties drive beginning on July 1st and continuing until July 30th. A flyer with a list of needed items will be also be an insert in this bulletin. A receptacle to place your donation in will be in the back of the church. All donations will be delivered to the regional food bank when the drive ends. Let's help support our neighbors in need—one hygiene product at a time.
