

CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD SUNDAY NOVEMBER 5, 2023 AT 9AM

Children's Liturgy Of The Word occurs on the First Sunday of each month at 9am from November to June.

Before the Scripture readings begin, children are called forward and sent with a blessing to the Church hall for a Gospel lesson. They will hear the same Scriptures that are proclaimed at Mass. but explained on a level that younger children can understand. Children's Liturgy is a way of helping children enter into this celebration more fully by using terms that are more appropriate to their level of understanding. Children's Liturgy of The Word is NOT Catechesis (religious education) or babysitting. It IS Liturgy of the Word, so it is centered on the proclamation and breaking open of the scriptures. The children do what the rest of the community is doing at this point of the Mass. It is an experience of prayer, of dialogue with God. All children are welcome regardless of age or if they are attending a Faith Formation program. To invite the high school students to participate, they will be taking on the roles of lectors, gift bearers and ushers. My goal is to make this Mass an entire family experience.



ADORATION

The Faith Formation students have been learning about Eucharistic Adoration. Since we now have the Blessed Sacrament exposed in the Chapel from 6pm to 7pm on Wednesdays, the children are able to adore Jesus as part of their Formation experience.
